IHESJR Faculty Scholar **Dr. Samantha Garbers** recently published an editorial in *The BMJ* entitled “US abortion restrictions are causing widespread harm,” reviewing emerging data on the harm of abortion restrictions. Dr. Garbers wrote the article in collaboration with colleagues at CUNY, including human rights lawyer and public health practitioner Terry McGovern. The article was selected as the *BMJ* Editor’s choice during the week of August 25th.
