<i>Program Structure</i>	<p><b>Year 1:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 6 months in Medical Information</li><li>• 6 months in Medical Communications</li></ul> <p><b>Year 2:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 3-month rotations in Global Medical Affairs functions (e.g., Medical Excellence, Field Medical, Grants, IGOR, Pharmacovigilance)</li><li>• At least 25% of time supporting Medical Information and Medical Communications</li><li>• Opportunities to learn about Scientific Communications, Regulatory Affairs, Health Economics &amp; Outcomes Research, Biostatistics, Professional Development, and Commercial Organization through longitudinal projects</li><li>• Attend medical congresses (e.g., ASHP)</li></ul> <p>Other rotations can be arranged based on availability and interest of the fellow.</p>
